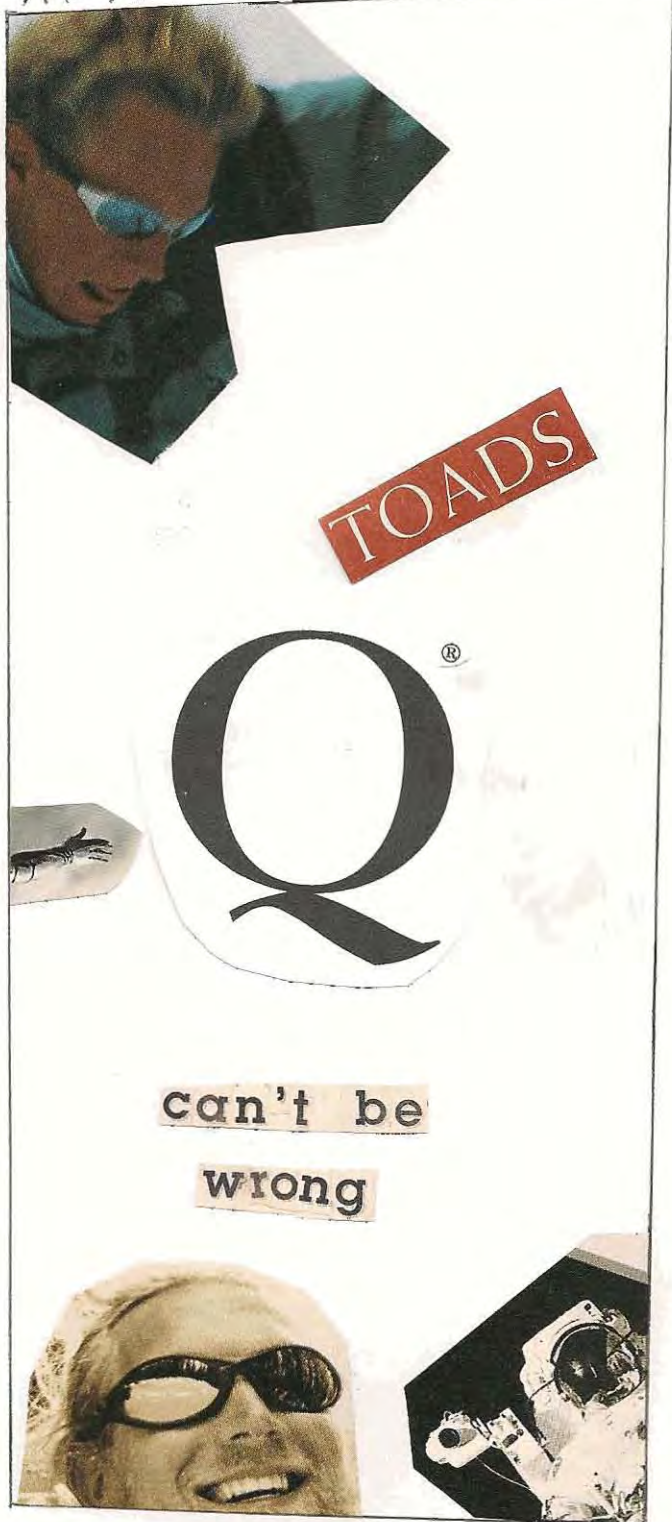
Henderson Demolishes Entire City, Aids Elderly In Fight For Rights

A: Suit yourself! We just wanna see blood.

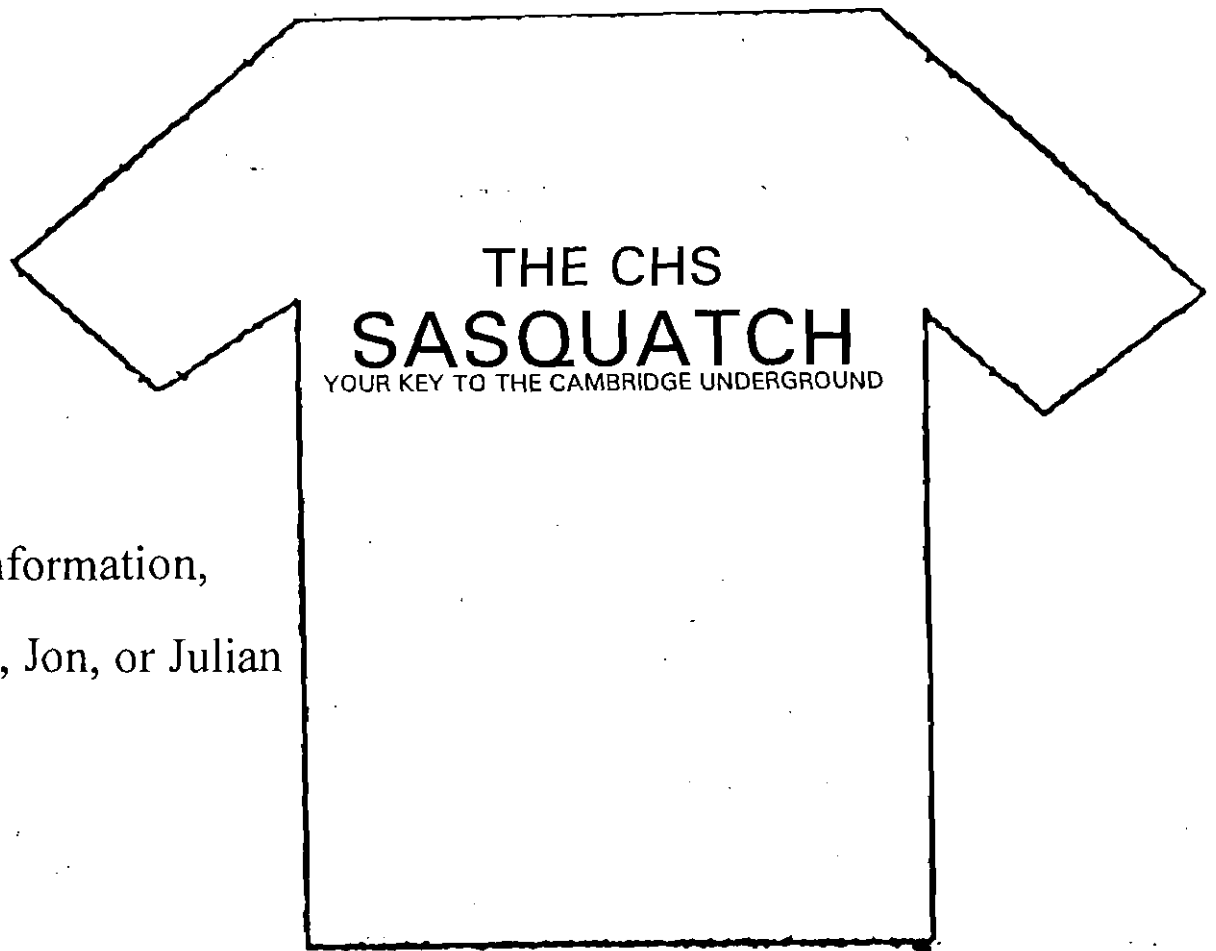
